



The new regulations will come into force on **25th May 2018**



The £10 fee will be removed, information must be provided **Free of Charge**



The statutory time limit for providing a response is reduced to **One Month**



Public Authorities must appoint a Data Protection Officer who will:



Inform and advise on the new regulations



Deliver staff training



Monitor compliance



Be the point of contact for the Information Commissioners Office

Individual rights are enhanced and include:

- The right to be **informed**
- The right of **access**
- The right to **rectification**
- The right to **erasure**



- The right to **restrict processing**
- The right to **data portability**
- The right to **object**
- Not to be subject to **automated decisions and profiling**

There are also new obligations for:

Seeking and Recording Consent

Recording and Responding to Breaches
